| Ensuring Volunteer Safety <i>A learning task for a brief meeting</i> | |
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| <p>ANCHOR</p>  | <p>Think about a time when you or someone you know volunteered for something.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>How safe did you feel?</i> • <i>Thinking back, what were some of the safety risks?</i> <p>Share first with a partner, and then in a full group.</p> |
| <p>ADD</p>  | <p>Listen to a brief presentation on the number of dog bites by month and year for the last 5 years.</p> <p>As you listen, jot down questions that come to mind and where there might be gaps in the story.</p> |
| <p>APPLY</p>  | <p>In partners, craft a story that you believe the data is telling us based on your experience. Write that story below.</p> <hr/> <p>In groups of 3-4 people, discuss these stories and list two (2) impacts you think this is having on your organization now or in the future. When ready, we'll hear stories and impacts from each group.</p> |
| <p>AWAY</p>  | <p>On your own, think about how we as a group might manage these impacts and what next steps you and your team can commit to.</p> |
