

Dotmocracy Voting

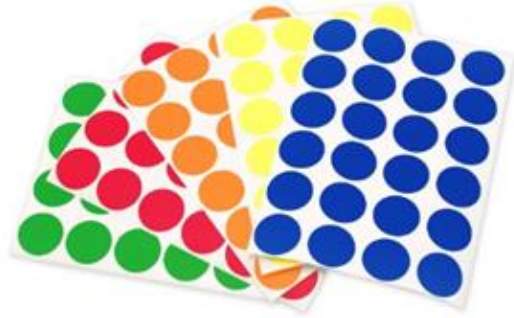
WHAT: A quick and easy-to-use technique to check where people's interests are.

WHY: To make a decision on direction or focus, inviting in all voices, or to see where people are at.

HOW: Each person has a limited number (at least 3, never just 1) of colored dots and votes on a list of ideas.

WHEN: Any time a decision needs to be made or a focus needs to be determined; often after work has been completed to create a list of possible directions or the list of choices needs to be narrowed.

VIRTUAL APPLICATION: *Can be done in the Chat box, in a shared doc (Google, Microsoft, etc.), or with a poll.*
