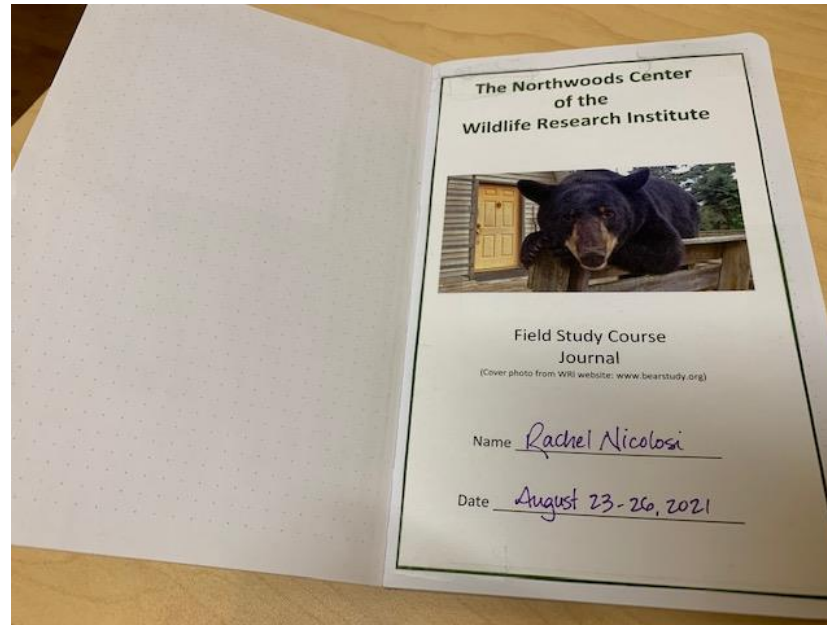
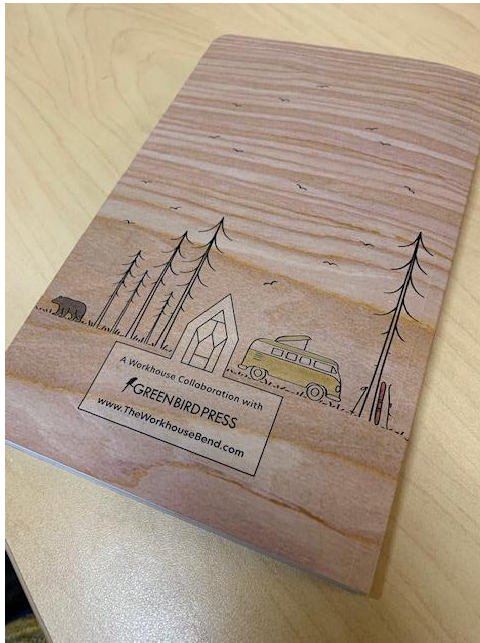

How Aggressive are Black Bears?

Working closely with wild black bears for over 48 years, Ely researchers never had one come after them and cause injury, even when they grabbed screaming cubs in front of mother bears. Minor nips and swats occurred only when researchers initiated the contact, and they were rare even then. Bear research turned out to be safer than home repairs and most sports.
