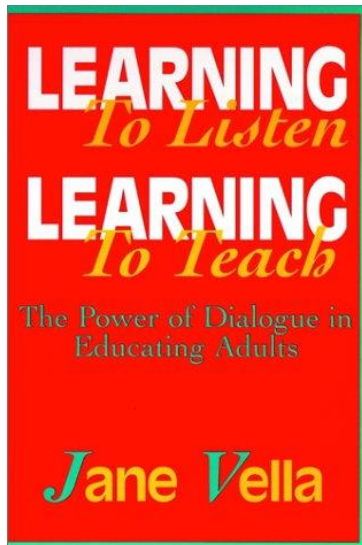
I hurried to the university library to find a copy of the prestigious journal. Oh my! They had photographed the red cover of the new book and the yellow letters did not show in the journal's text.
